Deep Valley Farms community supported agriculture (CSA) is a partnership between the local farmer and community members. Both the farmer and the community members share in the cost and risk of bringing in the harvest.

Membership in the CSA is based on a share in the harvest. Members in the CSA are called shareholders and they purchase a share of the harvest before the season begins.

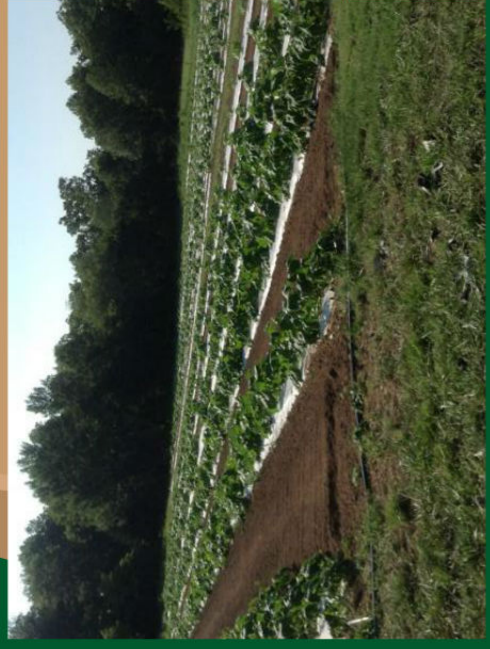

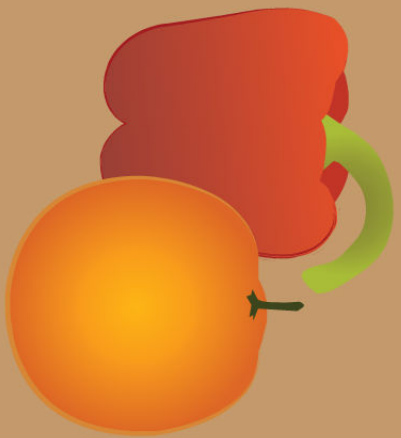

PRICING

Full share fills a 3/4 bushel basket and costs \$480 which feeds two on a vegetarian diet or a family of 4 on a regular diet for one week for 20 weeks. Half share fills a 1/2 bushel basket and costs \$320 which feeds 1-2 people for one week for 20 weeks. \$120 for any six weeks of the most productive 12 weeks.

Fresh, free-range chicken eggs can be purchased at any time for \$3/dozen or added to your share for \$60 for the entire season.

Free-range duck eggs can be purchased at any time for \$5.75/dozen.

Free range chickens processed at a USDA certified facility can be pre-ordered bi-weekly for \$10 per bird. The average weight is 2-2.5 or 3 lbs. Of this price, \$3 per bird is the processing fee paid to the USDA certified facility.
